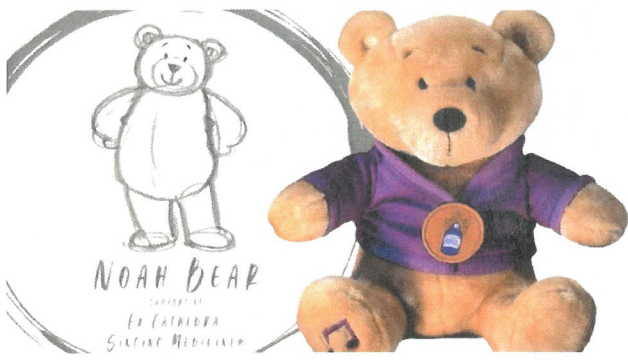




"The day the singing stopped, the world fell silent and the only voice that could be heard was Noah's."
