### Hello Everybody

#### Teacher Notes

This is the second of our introductory songs, but this one moves into the realm of warming up as well. It is based on a 'my turn, your turn' structure and it is clear when children listen and when children sing back. Encourage your children to get familiar with our song, then try and make it their own by making their own new words and actions and getting a family member to sing back to them. If you are gathering your class together on zoom (or other) sessions this is a lovely song that works well in this new world! Sing instructions to them and every can watch everyone doing them! You sing and they sing back with their mics off.

This is a useful song to develop children's beginner music skills. There is a strong apparent pulse, and the 'my turn your turn' structure helps them develop their listening and copying skills in pitch and rhythm.

#### Children Notes

Press play, be ready to listen and sing back, also copying the movements. It is clear when you have to listen and when you have to sing back and copy. When you are familiar with how the song works try making up your own lines and actions getting a family member to sing back to you. Maybe you could try it over facetime or zoom (or whatever you use!) when you next call friends. Have fun!
